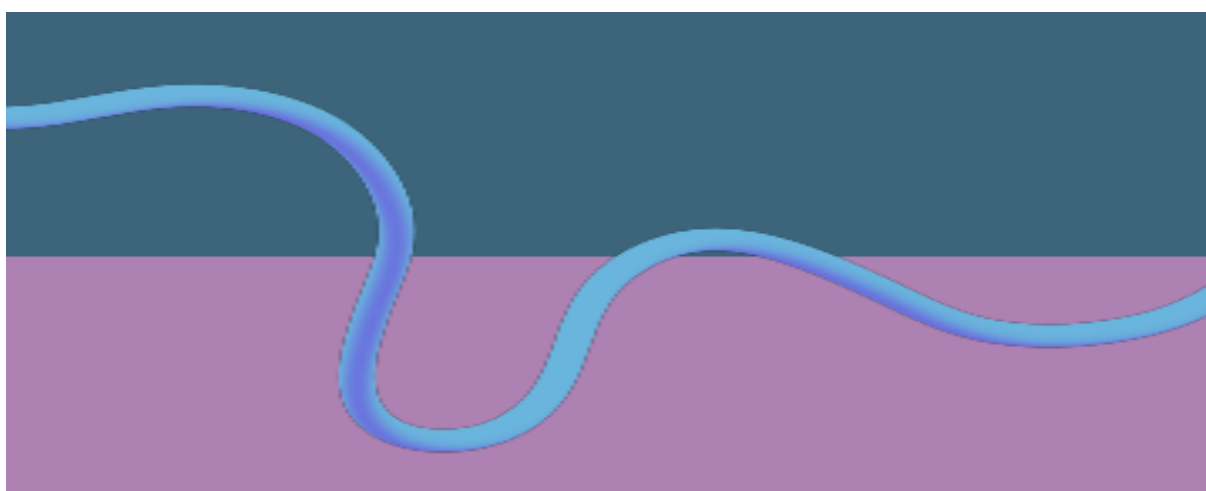


Nutrition for Growth (N4G) Paris 27th and 28th March 2025 Practical information

Welcome to Paris!

Nowadays, not a single country is spared from the scourge of malnutrition, which affects a third of the world's population. Poor nutrition is responsible for half of all child deaths: 150 million children under the age of 5 suffer from stunted growth, and 45 million are emaciated. Similarly, 2.5 billion adults are overweight. This situation, in addition to being blatantly unfair, affects all our economies and places a heavy burden on our countries' healthcare systems. The Nutrition for Growth (N4G) summit will be held in Paris on 27 and 28 March 2025. It will be a key moment for mobilisation, five years before the deadline for achieving the objectives of the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The ambition is clear: to put nutrition at the heart of the development agenda, to elevate the fight against malnutrition in all its forms to the status of a universal cause, to ensure continuity between N4G summits and to maintain a high level of political and financial commitment to nutrition.



Summit's venues

The Summit will take place on two main venues, located approximately ten minutes' walk from each other.

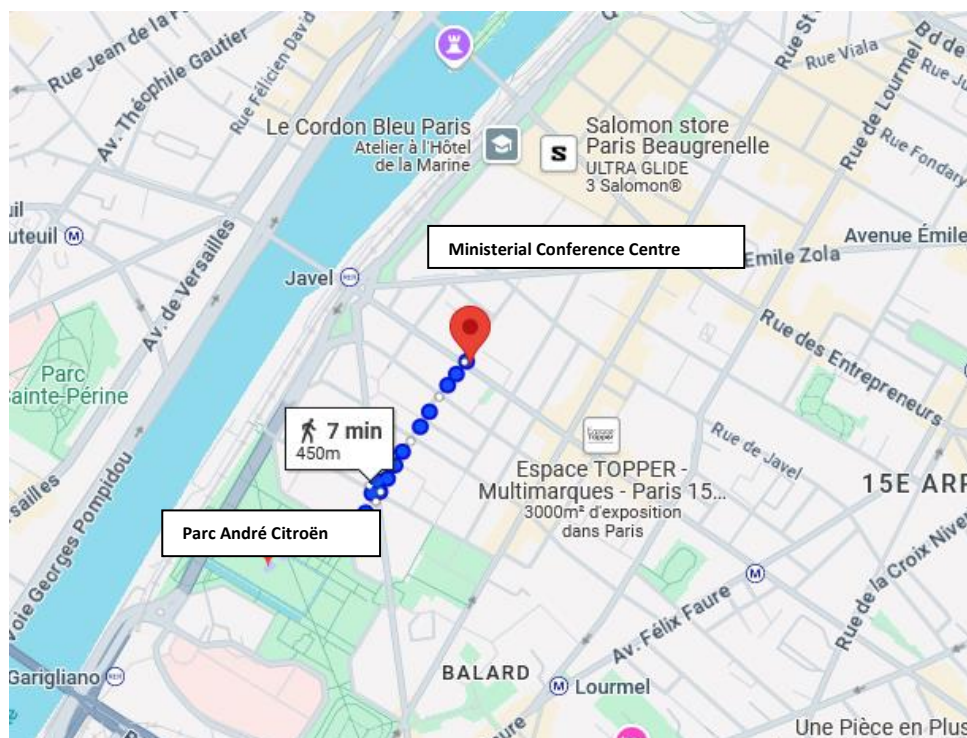

Entry into France

Nationals of countries subject to visa requirements should consult the France-Visas website (www.france-visas.gouv.fr) to find out whether they need a visa to enter France.

Delegates are advised to submit their visa applications as soon as possible to allow sufficient time for visa processing. Visas must be obtained in advance and cannot be issued on arrival.

In countries where there is no French consulate, France may be represented by another Schengen country able to process applications.

Transportation from airports

From Paris-Charles de Gaulle (CDG) airport, 25 km north-east of Paris, there are several options for getting to the centre:

- RER B serves Gare du Nord and Châtelet-Les Halles in 40 minutes (€13)
- The Roissybus runs to Opéra in around 60 minutes (€13)
- Buses 350 and 351 run to Gare de l'Est and Nation respectively in 60 to 80 minutes (€2.15)

From Paris-Orly (ORY) airport, 13 km to the south, you can reach the centre by public transport:

- Metro 14, the fastest way to reach the centre in 25 minutes
- RER B and C trains via OrlyVal take 30 to 35 minutes to reach Châtelet

Taxis and VTCs are also available near the terminals for immediate service or by reservation to the centre of Paris.

Getting to the N4G Summit

The Summit venues are **accessible by public transport**.

- By metro: line 10, line 8, line 12
- By RER : line C
- By tramway : line T3a
- By bus : line 30, line 42, line 62, line 88, line 169



Site access and security controls

- Delegation members with access to the plenary sessions will be dropped off at **no.29 Rue de la Convention**, and will make their way to CCM forecourt on foot.
- Delegation members taking part in Level 0 activities (listening rooms, round tables, inside events) will access the site via the **rue Menard entrance**.

Only heads of delegation and VIPs (lapel pins) are exempt from security control. On the forecourt, all other members of the delegation will undergo a mandatory security check when they arrive at the site (security scanner and screening of luggage/personal effects). Please ensure that you are present sufficiently in advance to carry out these controls.

Catering

A buffet lunch will be provided at the CCM for all heads delegations and pass holders on Thursday 27 March.

- a) In the plenary room, discussions will be interpreted into French, English, Spanish, Portuguese and Arabic. An additional booth will be available for interpreters accompanying certain government delegations.
- b) Round table discussions will be interpreted into French, English and Spanish. An additional booth will be available for interpreters accompanying certain government delegations.

Currency and payments

In France, the currency is the euro (EUR). Shops, restaurants and public transport accept both credit cards and cash.

Weather

Paris weather in March is generally mild, with occasional rain showers. The average temperature during this period ranges from 5 to 12 degrees Celsius.

Mobile Roaming and internet access

Please check with your telephone provider whether you can use roaming in France. Free WIFI access will be available throughout the Summit at the Ministerial Conference Centre (27 rue de la Convention).
